

Summer 2010 at Camp Pendola

Session Dates

June 20-26 – Girls Only
June 27 – July 3 – Girls Only
July 7-10 – Mini Session-Coed
July 11-17 – Boys Only
July 18-24 - Coed
July 25-31 – Coed
August 1-7 - Coed

Traditional Camp fees for the above dates is \$400 if registered before May 15th and \$415 after May 15th, except for July 7-10. The session beginning July 7 is \$200 if registered before May 15th; \$210 after May 15th. See below for fees for other sessions and activities.

Special Programs

Seedlings

Two options for Pendola's youngest campers are available in 2010. July 7th-10th or August 1st-4th is the Seedling program for boys and girls entering 1st and 2nd grades. We will be offering special cabin programming during these all mini sessions. Cost is \$200 if registered before May 15th and \$210 after May 15th.

Teen Canoe Trip

June 20-26 for girls and July 25 – 31 for boys entering at least grade 7. Cost for the session is \$410 if registered by May 15th and \$425 after May 15th. Campers must be able to swim comfortably in deep water to be eligible for this trip and will be required to pass a swim check upon arrival at camp.

Teen Backpacking Trip

June 27-July 3 for girls and July 11-27 for boys. Campers must be entering at least grade 7 in the fall of 2010. Cost for session is \$410 if registered by May 15th and \$425 after May 15th.

Coed Adventure Backpacking Trip

July 18 – 31 for boys and girls entering at least grade 9 in the fall of 2010. Cost for the trip is \$600 if registered by May 15th and \$620 after May 15th. Campers must provide their own framed backpack for this trip.

Campers-in-Leadership-Training (CILTs)

July 12-18 for youth entering grades 9 and 10 in the fall of 2010. Boys and girls will be housed separately but program will be coed. Cost is \$410 if registered by May 15th and \$425 after May 15th.

Counselor-in-Training for youth entering grades 11 and 12 in the fall of 2010 is scheduled for July 18-31. CIT training is a two year program. Youth must have completed to be CIT 1 to register for CIT 2.

Save a Place for Me!

A completed registration form, available online if not a part of this packet, plus a \$100 deposit per application, when received at the office will hold a space. Additional forms are available on the web page, www.pendola.org, or by calling the camp office, (916) 733-0127. Please keep a copy of your registration form for your records. Phone reservations are not accepted.

Financial Information

The **registration fee is \$100**. The deposit is part of the total fee with the balance of the camp fee due two weeks prior to the beginning of the session you are registered for. Fees may be paid using cash or checks payable to Camp Pendola. You are welcome to make installment payments at any time. **If campers need to stay over the weekend the fee is \$50.**

The Pendola Express: Bus transportation is available for an additional fee from Sacramento and Marysville. The cost is \$50 for roundtrip and \$30 for one way. Priority is given to round trip riders with space available on a first come first serve basis. The drop site in Sacramento is at the Pastoral Center at 2110 Broadway and in Marysville at St. Joseph's Church, 319 Seventh Street. Return Bus transportation is not available for the August session of Seedlings.

Financial Aid: Scholarships are available to qualifying campers. Call the Pendola Center office at 1-916-733-0127 for an application. Applications may also be downloaded from www.pendola.org. The funds are raised at the annual Camp Pendola Golf Tournament and will not be available until after May 15th. Applications received after May 15th will be considered if funds remain available.

Pendola Center is committed to helping make it possible for all children to attend camp. Campership funds are available to children of all faiths, between the ages of 6 and 17 who can participate in and benefit from the program. Varying amounts of financial assistance are offered depending upon need.

Camper Buddy Discount: Bring a new friend to camp for the week and earn a \$25 discount on you and your buddy's registration fees (limit one per person). Buddy Campers cannot have attended camp in the past two years.

Multi-Child or Multi-Week Discount: 1 \$25 discount off the full fee will be applied for additional weeks or additional children from the same household.

Refund Policy: If your cancellation occurs prior to June 15th, then all fees are refundable, less a \$50 administrative fee and any bus fares. If your cancellation occurs after June 15th, then all fees are non-refundable. No refunds are given to families of children who must be sent home due to improper behavior.

Arrival: Information will be sent after receiving your registration form. Bus transportation is available from Sacramento and Marysville for an additional fee.

Departure: Information will be sent after receiving your registration form. Campers must have written permission from their parents to leave camp with someone other than a legal guardian.

Confirmation/Cancellation

A detailed information packet including a packing list will be mailed to campers after they register. Campers will be notified if session is full. Camp Pendola reserves the right to cancel any session or program for just reason. Prompt notice will be given.

Camp Housing

Campers at Pendola will live in primitive screened cabins. Girls will live with other girls and a female counselor. Boys will live with other boys and a male counselor. Restrooms and showers are located down the hill from the cabins. During their week, all campers will spend at least one night

sleeping "under the stars" with their cabin and two counselors.

Work Weekends: May 22-23 and May 29-31
